

The Importance of State Defense Realization for the Young Generation in Building National Character

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Abstract

Defending the Country is a concept that has long been known in Indonesia as an effort to build a strong national character and integrity. However, in its development, there are challenges for the younger generation to understand the true meaning of Defending the Country. This research was conducted with the aim of examining the importance of realizing State Defense for the younger generation through related literature studies. The research method used is a literature study by collecting data from journals, books and articles related to the concept of State Defense and the importance of the realization of State Defense for the younger generation. The results of the study show that the realization of State Defense has an important role in shaping quality national character, especially in the younger generation. 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INTRODUCTION

This will make a positive contribution to the development of quality human resources in Indonesia and strengthen Indonesia's position at the global level. However, today, the younger generation is faced with challenges in understanding and applying the concept of Defending the Country in their daily lives. As the nation's next generation, they must have concern and a sense of responsibility towards the nation and state. Therefore, it is important to review the concept of State Defense and how it can be applied to the younger generation, so that it can form a strong national character and integrity in the future.

In this study, the author will examine the importance of realizing State Defense for the younger generation in shaping quality national character. This research is expected to provide a better understanding of the concept of State Defense and identify the factors that influence the realization of State Defense in the younger generation. RESEARCH METHODS

The method used in this study is a qualitative method with a literature review or literature review approach. Qualitative research is a type of scientific research that focuses on disclosing and in-depth understanding of observed social phenomena through descriptive and interpretive approaches. In this method, researchers attempt to describe and understand these social symptoms in detail and depth (Hardani et al., 2020). Literature study research techniques are a series of scientific activities that aim to collect information relevant to the topic or problem that is being or will be studied, using reference sources from various literature or literature. In this technique, researchers collect data by reading, studying, and evaluating literature that is relevant to the research topic. Thus, literature study research techniques allow researchers to gain an in-depth understanding of research topics through existing reference sources, and can be used as a basis or reference in preparing a research conceptual framework (Indra and Cahyaningrum, 2019). Data is collected from sources related to the concept of State Defense and the importance of realizing State Defense for the younger generation, such as journals, books, articles and other related documents. The data were then analyzed using a qualitative descriptive approach, with the aim of obtaining a comprehensive picture of the importance of realizing State Defense for the younger generation in building quality national character.



RESEARCH RESULTS AND DISCUSSION State Defense

State Defense is a concept that has been known since ancient times in Indonesia. This concept has a very important meaning in building a national character that is strong, tough, and has a sense of love for the motherland. Defending the State has various meanings and interpretations that have developed in line with changing times and socio-political conditions in Indonesia. Initially, State Defense was a concept related to national defense and the military. However, along with the times, this concept has expanded and developed into a broader concept that includes all aspects of social, national and state life (Juliannisa, I. A, et al, 2022). Currently, State Defense is not only related to national defense and the military, but also related to education, culture and the environment. In the Indonesian context, Defending the Country also includes the concept of citizen obligations in maintaining the integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia, respecting Pancasila and the 1945 Constitution, and carrying out state tasks in whatever form according to their respective capabilities and expertise.

This conception of Defending the Country contains five essential values, namely love for the motherland, awareness of the nation and state, belief in Pancasila as the state ideology, readiness to sacrifice for the sake of the nation and state, and having initial capabilities in Defending the State (Wiranto, I. el al. 2017).

Law Number 39 of 1999 concerning Human Rights and Law Number 3 of 2002 concerning National Defense elaborate further on these constitutional rights and obligations. Article 68 in the Law on Human Rights emphasizes that every citizen has an obligation to participate in efforts to defend the state in accordance with applicable regulations. Meanwhile, Article 9 paragraph (1) in the Law on State Defense states that every citizen has the right and obligation to be involved in efforts to defend the country which is manifested in the implementation of national defense.

Article 9 paragraph (2) then explains that the participation of citizens in efforts to defend the country can be carried out in various ways, such as civic education, basic military training, voluntary or compulsory service as TNI soldiers, and service according to their respective professions. The concept of Defending the Country in the context of nationality and national interests refers to the understanding that every citizen has the responsibility and obligation to maintain the unity, sovereignty and integrity of the country. Defending the Country is an effort to build a national spirit, national and state awareness, and create readiness in facing threats both from within and from outside. The concept of Defending the Country in the context of



national interests also implies that citizens have a responsibility to protect national interests, both in the political, economic, social, and defense and security fields.

This means that every citizen must have awareness not to take actions that are detrimental to national interests, and participate in state development and strengthen national defense (Emillia, S. H. 2022). In the concept of State Defense, national interests are prioritized over individual or group interests. Therefore, every citizen must have a high sense of nationalism, so as to maintain the integrity of the state and nation. Apart from that, the concept of Defending the State also requires unity in maintaining public order and security and preventing conflicts that harm national interests.

The Importance of State Defense Realization for the Young Generation

The younger generation refers to the age group that is in the transition period from childhood to adulthood, generally in the age range of 15-30 years. (Tuhuteru, L. 2022). The younger generation is considered the future of the nation because they will become leaders and decision makers in the future. However, the younger generation is also faced with various challenges and problems, such as problems with education, unemployment, mental health, and the negative impacts of technological advances. For this reason, the younger generation must be equipped with state defense education so that Indonesia's young generation becomes a golden generation that has a strong national character.

The role of State Defense is very important in shaping the nation's character because through the implementation of State Defense, a person will learn to love their homeland and nation, be aware of the importance of togetherness, and understand the values contained in Pancasila as the state ideology (Kristiani, R. In this case, the strengthening of the nation's character is mainly carried out through the State Defense coaching and training program that targets the younger generation. Through this program, the younger generation can be given understanding and knowledge about the importance of having initial skills in Defending the Country. In its implementation, the Bela Negara program can foster a sense of responsibility, social care, discipline, and a strong sense of leadership in the younger generation. Thus, the role of Defending the State is very important in forming a strong national character and integrity, which will ultimately strengthen the nation and national interests.

The younger generation in Indonesia faces several challenges in understanding and applying the concept of Defending the Country. In addition, Indonesia has a rich and unique cultural diversity, but



many young people do not appreciate and maintain this cultural wealth (Ratri, E. P., and Najicha, F. U. 2022). This can lead to the loss of the nation's noble values which are one of the foundations of the concept of Defending the Country.

To overcome this challenge, the government requires character, moral and State Defense education as compulsory subjects in schools. The role of parents, teachers, friends and the community environment is also important in providing education to children so that they are able to apply the values of Defending the Country in their daily lives. It is important to create social harmony by developing good relationships and interactions with other ethnic groups and developing tolerance (Abubakar, H. M., et al, 2018). That way, the younger generation of Indonesia can understand and apply the concept of Defending the Country properly and become a generation that contributes positively to the nation and state. For this reason, the Realization of State Defense is needed, especially for the younger generation.

The realization of State Defense can assist in the formation of a strong and resilient national character. Through understanding and practicing the concept of Defending the Country, the younger generation can develop an attitude of nationalism, awareness of the nation and state, a sense of responsibility towards the country, and love for the homeland and the Indonesian nation (Widodo, S. 2011). This will form a national character that is strong and has noble character, and is ready to contribute in building and maintaining the integrity of the country.

In addition, through experience and training in crisis or emergency situations related to Defending the Country, the younger generation can develop leadership skills, teamwork, courage, mental resilience, and the ability to face challenges and difficulties. This will also form a strong and resilient national character, capable of facing increasingly complex and diverse global challenges. The relationship between the realization of State Defense and the formation of national character has a close relationship. The concept of Defending the Country has the aim of forming citizens who have awareness and responsibility towards the state and nation, and are ready to protect the sovereignty of the state and the territorial integrity of the state (Manurung, Y. Through the realization of Defending the Country, one is taught to have awareness and a sense of responsibility towards the state and its people, and to understand the importance of maintaining the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the country. The concept of Defending the Country also trains a person to be disciplined, tough and have a high spirit of patriotism. This can form a national character that is tough, strong, and has a high national spirit. In addition, the realization of Defending the Country also teaches important moral values in shaping the nation's character, such as honesty, togetherness, and mutual respect. This can form a national character that has good ethics and morals in the life of society, nation and state.

- 4. The government must provide incentives and awards to individuals or groups who have made a real contribution to efforts to build national character through the State Defense program.
- 5. The government must provide training and debriefing for teachers and educational staff regarding appropriate and effective State Defense teaching materials and methods.



- 6. The government must optimize social media and information technology as a means of disseminating information and education about Defending the Country.
- 7. The State Defense Program must be adapted to the social, cultural and religious conditions of the Indonesian people, so that it is easily accepted and can be implemented properly.
- 8. The State Defense Program must pay attention to the factors that influence the realization of State Defense, such as social, cultural and environmental factors.
- 9. The government must continue to strengthen coordination between institutions and sectors in the implementation of the State Defense program, so that this program can run effectively and efficiently.

For further research, there are several suggestions that can be taken: Using a qualitative approach: This study has used a quantitative approach with survey methods as a data collection tool. However, qualitative research can provide a deeper understanding of the factors that influence the realization of State Defense. Involving a wider sample: This study only involved respondents from one city. Future research can expand the sample of respondents from several different cities or regions in Indonesia. Comparing with other countries: Future research can compare the realization of State Defense in the younger generation in Indonesia with other countries to see the differences and similarities in the factors that influence it.

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
